**ORDER GRANTING UNOPPOSED MOTION
FOR TEMPORARY STAY OF DISCOVERY**

This Court has considered, without hearing, Plaintiffs' unopposed motion for temporary stay of discovery. ECF No. 133. The motion is **GRANTED**. In light of the passage of S.B. 7066 (with provisions in it relevant to this lawsuit) and the bill not yet being presented to the Governor of Florida for his signature, a stay is appropriate.

Accordingly, this matter is stayed until **June 13, 2019**. All discovery deadlines are also stayed during this period.
