**STIPULATION TO HOLD IN ABEYANCE PROCEEDINGS REGARDING  
ATTORNEYS' FEES AND COSTS**

---

The parties, by their attorneys, hereby stipulate to extend the deadlines for filing petitions for attorneys' fees and costs and the filing of bills of costs in the above captioned actions.

On April 29, 2014, this Court entered a Decision and Order [Doc. #195] permanently enjoining Defendants from conditioning a person's access to a ballot on that person's presenting a form of photo identification. The Court entered judgment for Plaintiffs and against Defendants on the same date. [Doc. #196.] Defendants intend to take an appeal to the United States Court of Appeals for the Seventh Circuit.

Pursuant to F. R. Civ. P. 54 and Civil Local Rule 54(a), the parties stipulate to extend the

deadline for filing motions for attorneys' fees and costs and the bills of costs until 30 days after the United States Court of Appeals for the Seventh Circuit has decided the anticipated appeals in these actions.

As more fully set forth in the parties' Joint Motion for an Order Holding In Abeyance Proceedings Regarding Attorneys' Fees and Costs, filed herewith, the parties agree that the interests of justice, as well as interests of judicial economy, will be served by holding all fee and cost issues in abeyance until after such time as appellate proceedings in the Court of Appeals are completed.

Accordingly, the parties hereby stipulate and agree to extend the deadline for filing motions for attorneys' fees and costs and bills of costs until 30 days after the appeal to the Court of Appeals is decided.

If the Defendants do not appeal either or both of the above captioned cases, the Parties agree that the Plaintiffs in any such case shall file their motion(s) for fees and costs and their bills of costs within 30 days after the time to appeal has elapsed.
