Dear Judge Adelman:

I am writing with regard to Defendants' pending Motions to Stay Permanent Injunction Pending Appeal in the above cases. (*Frank*, Dkt. #201; *LULAC*, Dkt. #133.) The motions have been fully briefed and awaiting disposition in this Court since June 6, 2014.

On July 31, 2014, the Wisconsin Supreme Court entered decisions upholding Act 23 in the face of challenges brought under the Wisconsin Constitution. See *League of Women Voters of Wisconsin Education Network, Inc. v. Walker*, 2014 WI 97, \_\_\_ Wis. 2d \_\_\_, \_\_\_ N.W.2d \_\_\_, and *Milwaukee Branch of the NAACP v. Walker*, 2014 WI 98, \_\_\_ Wis. 2d \_\_\_, \_\_\_, N.W.2d \_\_\_.

In light of these decisions, we respectfully request that you promptly dispose of the pending motions. Our clients yesterday received guidance from the Wisconsin Supreme Court that Act 23 is lawful. This Court's conflicting permanent injunction should be stayed pending appeal.
