**PLAINTIFFS' UNOPPOSED MOTION TO EXTEND TIME TO REPLY AND FOR
LEAVE TO FILE AN OVERSIZED REPLY MEMORANDUM**

Plaintiffs, through their counsel, file this unopposed motion to extend the deadline for filing their reply to Defendants' Brief in Opposition to Plaintiffs' Motions for a Permanent Injunction, Class Certification, and Judgment, and for leave to file an oversized memorandum.

On April 24, 2015, Defendants filed their opposition to Plaintiffs' Motions for a Permanent Injunction, Class Certification, and Judgment. (Dkt. #228.) That brief is comprised of 26 single-spaced pages, in violation of General L.R. 5(a)(4). Had the brief been double-spaced, as required by this rule, it would have been well over the page limit for opposition briefs. *See* Civil L.R. 7(f).

At the status conference held on April 1, 2015, this Court set a May 15, 2015 deadline for Plaintiffs' reply brief. (Dkt. #226.) Pursuant to General L.R. 5(a)(4) and Civil L.R. 7(f), Plaintiffs' reply memorandum would normally be limited to 15 double-spaced pages. In light of Defendants having filed an oversized brief, Plaintiffs seek, and Defendants have agreed to, a

one-week extension and up to 15 additional pages in order for Plaintiffs to adequately respond, pending this Court's approval.

Plaintiffs therefore respectfully request an order extending the time to file their reply to Defendants' opposition until May 22, 2015, and granting leave to file an oversized reply memorandum of a maximum of 30 pages.
