We represent Plaintiffs in the above-captioned case. After Plaintiffs filed their opposition to Defendants' expedited motion to compel the disclosure of un-redacted survey data yesterday (Dkt. ## 142, 143, 144), counsel for Defendants repeatedly insisted that Plaintiffs formally withdraw the memorandum because it cites to two declarations rather than one. (*See* e-mail correspondence attached as Exhibit A.) We believe that our filing was proper under the local rules. But rather than wasting this Court's valuable time with motion practice over this issue, attached as Exhibit B is a substantively identical opposition brief that cites to only one declaration rather than two.

We withdraw the declaration filed at docket entry 143, which contained only copies of authorities cited in our brief, which were provided for the Court's convenience. The new brief attached as Exhibit B contains citations to websites where such authorities can be obtained by the Court.
