Requests for extensions of time to file a response may not be entertained.

After fourteen (14) days, this court will consider any response(s) received and any portion of the record that may be required to resolve the jurisdictional issue(s). Please note that the issuance of a jurisdictional question does not stay the time for filing appellant's briefs otherwise provided by 11th Cir. R. 31-1.

Address whether and to what extent this Court has jurisdiction over the appeal from the district court's October 4, 2012, interlocutory order denying Plaintiffs-Appellants' motion for preliminary injunction and summary judgment as an interlocutory order granting injunctive relief under 28 U.S.C. § 1292(a)(1). *See Solantic, LLC v. City of Neptune Beach*, 410 F.3d 1250, 1272-74 (11th Cir. 2005) (concerning the scope of this Court's jurisdiction over appeals from interlocutory orders granting or denying injunctions); *Massey v. Cong. Life Ins. Co.*, 116 F.3d 1414, 1416-17 (11th Cir. 1997) (same).
