ORDER ENTERED PURSUANT TO JOINT MOTION

Upon consideration of the parties' Joint Motion for Entry of an Order Holding in Abeyance Proceedings Regarding Attorneys' Fees and Costs and the Parties' Stipulation; and

It appearing to the Court that the interests of justice will be served by holding all fee and cost issues in abeyance until after the Court of Appeals enters its mandate and final disposition of any further proceedings on appeal before the Court of Appeals or the United States Supreme Court occurs;

It is therefore,

ORDERED, that the joint motion is granted, and all issues relating to an award of attorneys' fees and costs shall be held in abeyance until after the Court of Appeals enters its mandate and final disposition of any further proceedings on appeal before the Court of Appeals or the Supreme Court occurs. No further filings or actions related to fees and costs shall be required sooner than 30 days after the Court of Appeals enters its mandate or 30 days after the final disposition of any further proceedings on review before the Court of Appeals or the Supreme Court, whichever is later. Plaintiffs need not file objections to, or make payment upon, the Bill of Costs filed by Defendants in the Court of Appeals before that time.
