¹ Plaintiffs previously filed a motion asking the Court to extend the page limit for memorandums in support of this motion and their motion for a preliminary injunction. The parties disagreed on the number of pages that should be permitted. At a hearing on May 9, 2014, undersigned counsel recall that the Court indicated that because of the importance of this case, it would not unreasonably limit the length of memoranda in support of these motions. Accordingly, Defendants have submitted a memorandum, the length of which is consistent with their earlier position in connection with Plaintiffs' motion.
