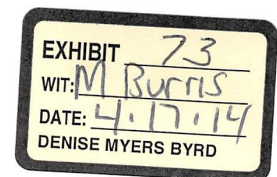

SUBJECT: SBOE & NCDMV Voter Registration Database ID Analysis

On or about, February 10, 2011, the State Board of Elections provided the North Carolina Department of Motor Vehicles with 334,651 voter records for further analysis. After the February 2, 2011 crosscheck of DMV customer records and SBOE voter registration records, there were 334,651 voters with a driver license number on the voter record that did not match any information in the data provided by DMV. The February 2nd review had examined valid ID information from the DMV. The DMV was asked to conduct further analysis to determine if the information in the voters' record matched other criteria like revoked, expired or suspended licenses.

Following the DMV review of these 334,651 records, the State Board of Elections has determined the following:

- 329,017 voters' licenses were revoked or expired
- 5627 voters' licenses are confirmed valid
- 7 voters have license information on their voter record that could not be identified by the DMV
