Barb,

Part 12 of House Bill 589 eliminates the preregistration. Pending the signing of the bill by Gov. McCrory, this would mean that voter registration services, effective September 1, 2013, should no longer be offered to 16 year-olds at the DMV. Voter registration services could be offered to 17 year-olds, since in the event of an upcoming general election, some could be eligible to be registered and vote in an upcoming primary for that general election. Again, this bill has not yet been signed, but given the time in which this bill would be effective, I wanted to give you a heads up.
