FIRST STIPULATION REGARDING INFORMATION IN THE SEIMS DATABASE

The United States and Defendants stipulate that the following appendices accurately reflect the information contained in the SEIMS database¹ as of June 10, 2015, with respect to the corresponding groups of registered voters identified by the United States as having discoverable information related to the effect of HB 589 on their right to vote:

- (1) voters with information related to the reduction of the number of early voting days and prohibition on counting out-of-precinct provisional ballots (Appendix A);
- (2) voters with information related to the elimination of same-day registration during the early voting period (Appendix B); and
- (3) voters with information related to the imposition of the photo identification requirement (Appendix C).
