Pursuant to Rule 201(b)(2) of the Federal Rules of Evidence, the United States respectfully asks the Court to take judicial notice of the following data produced by the U.S. Census Bureau. Rule 201(b)(2) permits a court to judicially notice facts “not subject to reasonable dispute” because they “can be accurately and readily determined from sources whose accuracy cannot reasonably be questioned.” Courts have routinely concluded that “United States census data is an appropriate and frequent subject of judicial notice.” *Hollinger v. Home State Mut. Ins. Co.*, 654 F.3d 564, 571–72 (5th Cir. 2011); *see also United States v. Gregory*, 871 F.2d 1239, 1245 (4th Cir. 1989) (taking judicial notice of U.S. Census Bureau data); *United States v. Cecil*, 836 F.2d 1431, 1452 (4th Cir. 1988) (en banc); *United States v. Dreyer*, 767 F.3d 826, 834 n.12 (9th Cir. 2014); *Bradshaw v. Associated Transp., Inc.*, No. C-245-G-67, 1974 WL 232, at \*5 (M.D.N.C. July 26, 1974).

Facts regarding population and voting-age population figures from Census 2000 and Census 2010 (100% data) reflect the aggregation and allocation of multiple race respondents as set forth in guidance issued by the Office of Management and Budget, OMB Bulletin 00-02 (Mar. 9, 2000), *available at* [http://www.whitehouse.gov/omb/bulletins\\_b00-02](http://www.whitehouse.gov/omb/bulletins_b00-02), and the Department of Justice, 76 Fed. Reg. 7470, 7472 (Feb. 9, 2011), 66 Fed. Reg. 5411, 5414 (Jan. 18, 2001); *see also Georgia v. Ashcroft*, 539 U.S. 461, 474 n.1 (2003). Pursuant to that guidance, counts for persons who reported a single minority race are aggregated with those persons who reported a combination of white and that minority race. For example, the appropriate

population counts for non-Hispanic black persons include all persons who self-identified on the Census as not Hispanic and self-identified as black alone or black in combination with white.

Census sample data, including the 2006-2010 ACS and 2013 ACS, do not report racial groups aggregated as specified by OMB Bulletin 00-02 guidelines. Thus, ACS figures for non-Hispanic black persons reflect only those individuals who self-identified as non-Hispanic black alone, figures for non-Hispanic Asian persons reflect only those individuals who self-identified as non-Hispanic Asian alone, and figures for American Indian persons reflect only those individuals who self-identified as non-Hispanic American Indian alone.

This request for judicial notice utilizes the most recent ACS data compilation (ACS 2013 1-year estimates) for which Hispanic and non-Hispanic racial breakdowns are available on the Census Bureau's American Factfinder application. The exception to 2013 figures: ACS citizenship data distinguishing Hispanic and non-Hispanic persons by race (e.g., non-Hispanic black alone) are only available from the 2006-2010 ACS. Finally, ACS data are derived from population samples; therefore, they are reported with margins of error representing 90 percent confidence levels in the data's accuracy.

All census data supporting these facts are attached.

1. According to the 2000 Census, the State of North Carolina had a total population of 8,049,313 persons, including 5,647,155 non-Hispanic white persons (70.2%), 1,740,632 non-Hispanic black persons (21.6%), 378,963 Hispanic persons (4.7%),

124,058 non-Hispanic Asian persons (1.5%), and 113,865 non-Hispanic American Indian persons (1.4%). Ex. A.

2. According to the 2000 Census, the State of North Carolina had a voting-age population of 6,085,266 persons, including 4,418,686 non-Hispanic white persons (72.6%), 1,212,981 non-Hispanic black persons (19.9%), 258,873 Hispanic persons (4.2%), 87,571 non-Hispanic Asian persons (1.4%), and 79,932 non-Hispanic American Indian persons (1.3%). Ex. B.
3. According to the 2000 Census, the State of North Carolina had a citizen voting-age population of 5,820,423 persons, including 4,379,287 non-Hispanic white persons (75.2%), 1,193,817 non-Hispanic black persons (20.5%), 90,276 Hispanic persons (1.6%), 40,065 non-Hispanic Asian persons (0.7%), and 68,189 non-Hispanic American Indian persons (1.2%).<sup>1</sup> Ex. C.
4. According to the 2010 Census, the State of North Carolina has a total population of 9,535,483 persons, including 6,223,995 non-Hispanic white persons (65.3%), 2,076,800 non-Hispanic black persons (21.8%), 800,120 Hispanic persons (8.4%), 232,987 non-Hispanic Asian persons (2.4%), and 139,257 non-Hispanic American Indian persons (1.5%). Ex. D.
5. According to the 2010 Census, the State of North Carolina has a voting-age population of 7,253,848, including 4,964,325 non-Hispanic white persons

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<sup>1</sup> Citizen voting age counts are derived from Census 2000 sample data. As noted above, racial groups aggregated as specified by OMB Bulletin 00-02 guidelines are not available.

(68.4%), 1,495,360 non-Hispanic black persons (20.6%), 492,330 Hispanic persons (6.8%), 165,020 non-Hispanic Asian persons (2.3%), and 100,878 non-Hispanic American Indian persons (1.4%). Ex. E.

6. According to the 2006-2010 ACS, the State of North Carolina has a citizen voting-age population of 6,607,031 ( $\pm 4,653$ ) persons, including 4,813,304 ( $\pm 1,994$ ) non-Hispanic white persons (72.9%), 1,402,726 ( $\pm 2,319$ ) non-Hispanic black persons (21.2%), 160,650 ( $\pm 3,111$ ) Hispanic persons (2.4%), 81,635 ( $\pm 1,760$ ) non-Hispanic Asian persons (1.2%), and 72,561 ( $\pm 1,005$ ) non-Hispanic American Indian persons (1.1%). Ex. F.
7. According to the 2006-2010 ACS, approximately 34.1% of U.S. citizens residing in North Carolina were born outside of North Carolina in different states, in U.S. territories, or to American parents abroad including 38.9% ( $\pm 0.1\%$ ) of non-Hispanic white citizens, 25.8% ( $\pm 0.3\%$ ) of non-Hispanic black citizens, 22.7% ( $\pm 0.6\%$ ) of Hispanic citizens, 15.3% ( $\pm 0.9\%$ ) of non-Hispanic American Indian citizens, and 16.2% ( $\pm 0.8\%$ ) of non-Hispanic Asian citizens. Ex. G.
8. According to the 2013 ACS, 6.5% ( $\pm 0.2\%$ ) of North Carolina households did not have access to a motor vehicle, including 4.3% ( $\pm 0.2\%$ ) of non-Hispanic white households, 13.6% ( $\pm 0.7\%$ ) of non-Hispanic black households, 6.4% ( $\pm 1.0\%$ ) of Hispanic households, 9.2% ( $\pm 1.8\%$ ) of non-Hispanic American Indian households, and 4.3% ( $\pm 1.2\%$ ) of non-Hispanic Asian households. Ex. H at 7, 15, 23.

9. According to the 2013 ACS, 14.3% ( $\pm 0.3\%$ ) of workers in North Carolina age 16 years or over commute by carpool, public transportation, walking, or other means besides driving alone, including 10.9% ( $\pm 0.3\%$ ) of non-Hispanic white workers, 17.5% ( $\pm 0.9\%$ ) of non-Hispanic black workers, 31.2% ( $\pm 1.9\%$ ) of Hispanic workers, 14.2% ( $\pm 2.8\%$ ) of non-Hispanic American Indian workers, and 24.8% ( $\pm 2.9\%$ ) of non-Hispanic Asian workers. Ex. H at 5, 12-13, 20-21.
10. According to the 2013 ACS, 64.3% ( $\pm 0.4\%$ ) of occupied housing units in North Carolina are owner-occupied, including 72.1% ( $\pm 0.4\%$ ) of households headed by a non-Hispanic white person, 45.8% ( $\pm 0.9\%$ ) of households headed by a non-Hispanic black person, 39.8% ( $\pm 1.9\%$ ) of households headed by a Hispanic person, 69.4% ( $\pm 3.1\%$ ) of households headed by a non-Hispanic American Indian person, and 57.6% ( $\pm 3.1\%$ ) of households headed by a non-Hispanic Asian person. Ex. H at 7, 15, 23.
11. According to the 2013 ACS, 9.1% ( $\pm 0.2\%$ ) of the voting-age population of the State of North Carolina are military veterans, including 10.1% ( $\pm 0.2\%$ ) of non-Hispanic white persons, 9.0% ( $\pm 0.4\%$ ) of non-Hispanic black persons, 3.6% ( $\pm 0.4\%$ ) of Hispanic persons, 6.4% ( $\pm 1.1\%$ ) of non-Hispanic American Indian persons, and 1.2% ( $\pm 0.3\%$ ) of non-Hispanic Asian persons. Ex. H at 3, 11, 19.
12. According to the 2013 ACS, 12.2% ( $\pm 0.4\%$ ) of North Carolina residents aged one and over moved within the State in the past year, including 10.6% ( $\pm 0.4\%$ ) of non-Hispanic white persons, 15.9% ( $\pm 0.9\%$ ) of non-Hispanic black persons, 13.1%

(±1.2%) of Hispanic persons, 10.3% (±1.9%) of non-Hispanic American Indian persons, and 11.4% (±1.7%) of non-Hispanic Asian persons. Ex. H at 4, 11, 19.

13. According to the 2013 ACS, 3.7% (±0.2%) of North Carolina residents aged one and over moved from one county in North Carolina to another within the past year, including 3.6% (±0.2%) of non-Hispanic white persons, 4.2% (±0.4%) of non-Hispanic black persons, 2.7% (±0.5%) of Hispanic persons, 2.8% (±0.9%) of non-Hispanic American Indian persons, and 2.9% (±0.7%) of non-Hispanic Asian persons. Ex. H at 4, 11, 19.
