

ORDER
Granting Joint Motion to Voluntarily Dismiss Non-Party Registrars’
Motion to Quash Subpoenas

This matter is before the Court for resolution of non-dispositive matters pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(A) on Plaintiffs’ and Non-Party Registrars’ Joint Motion to Voluntarily Dismiss the Non-Party Registrars’ Motion to Quash Subpoenas (ECF No. 108). Upon consideration whereof and for good cause shown, the Court GRANTS the Joint Motion (ECF No. 108) and hereby:

1. ORDERS that the Non-Party Registrars’ Motion to Quash Subpoenas (ECF No. 103) is DISMISSED; and,
2. ORDERS that:
 - The Non-Party Registrars will produce on a rolling basis, documents responsive to Requests 7, 9, and 10 no later than December 22, 2015, and Non-Party Registrars will make every effort to produce documents responsive to Request 7 on or before December 18, 2015;
 - Upon receipt of these documents, or responses stating that no responsive documents are in the specific Registrar’s possession, Plaintiffs will deem that the Non-Party Registrars have fully complied with and satisfied the subpoenas served upon them; and,
 - Plaintiffs will not demand anything further from the Non-Party Registrars in response to the Non-Party Registrars’ subpoenas.

Let the Clerk file this Order electronically and notify all counsel accordingly.
