**DEFENDANTS' SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT
REGARDING DISTRIBUTION OF PROVISIONAL
BALLOT INFORMATION TO IDPP PETITIONERS**

This supplemental report is being filed to inform the Court of a minor adjustment to IDPP procedures that is important to prevent confusion for post-election IDPP customers.

DMV distributed a handout explaining provisional ballots to all IDPP petitioners, starting on November 4, 2016. (*See* Dkt. 310 ¶¶ 7–8, Ex. 2.) Now that the election is over, DMV has found that distributing the provisional ballot handout is causing customer confusion. (Supplemental Boardman Declaration¹ ¶ 3.) The handout, at this point, is not helpful because the next

election is not until February 21, 2017.² No voter in Wisconsin will encounter a provisional ballot until then, and customers now entering the IDPP will have a receipt long before the next election.

To prevent confusion, DMV is temporarily ceasing distribution of the provisional ballot handout. An updated provisional ballot handout will be distributed to all IDPP petitioners for future elections, including: from February 17–24, 2017, for the February 21, 2017 election; from March 31–April 7, 2017, for the April 4, 2017 election, and likewise for future elections, or until otherwise ordered by this Court or an appellate court. (Supplemental Boardman Declaration ¶ 5.)
