Concentration: Compliance

Concentration Curriculum

Offerings subject to change; most courses listed below are offered at least once per year.

Required M.S.L. Courses

Students must take the two foundational M.S.L. program courses:

- Legal Research and Writing for MSL Students (3 credits)
- US Legal Systems (3 credits)

Core Concentration Courses

Students must **Regulatory Compliance (3 credits)** and at least two of the following three courses to graduate with a concentration in Compliance:

- Health Care Compliance (3 credits)
- Financial Compliance (3 credits)
- Cyberlaw (2 credits)

Elective Concentration Courses

Students must take at least 8 credits from among the following courses:

- Compliance Externship (3 credits)
- Business Associations (3-4 credits)
- Accounting for Lawyers (2 credits)
- Employment Law (4 credits)
- Employment Discrimination Law (3 credits)
- Federal Income Taxation (3-4 credits)
- Securities (3 credits)

Optional Courses

Students may take their remaining credits from any from any other available courses.
